

Course Analysis for MATP33 Group and Ring Theory, Spring 2024

Course Evaluation

Summary of student's answers:

Over all, the comments from the students were positive, although only 4 students answered the evaluation of the course. As in previous semester, the most significant comment is concerning the large amount of material covered in the course.

Teachers' comments:

The course was taught closely following the previous realisation, including lectures, seminars, and weekly exercise sheets. The previous realisation of the course resulted in a set of lecture notes typset by the lecturer in LaTeX, and these were made available to the students through the Canvas page of the course since the beginning of the period. Students appreciated these lecture notes and it is hoped that they helped them to better prepare for attending each lecture (as the notes were followed very closely).

Changes from the previous course realisation:

The main change with respect to the previous course realisation was that greater effort was made to engage the students during the seminars, by asking them to be more active with questions and

to present their solutions on the board. However, only 2 or 3 students participated regularly in the seminars.

Suggestions for the next course realisation:


The main suggestion is to reduce the material covered in the course. Possible concrete changes include removing the topic "Tensor products of modules" from the course syllabus, as well as perhaps the proof of the Artin-Wedderburn Theorem. It is also possible to be less thorough in future realisations of the course, for example by not discussing concepts such as that of a projective module - discussing such concepts is desirable since this increases understanding but unfortunately the course has rather few teaching sessions.






Very high quality lecture notes and exercises therein. Also plenty of valuable feedback during the seminars. I would have liked to have solutions available online to look at


